

## FIDELITY HOUSE 2026

### Kindergarten & 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Camp

Fidelity House is offering a Camp for children who are entering Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> grade. There will be one-week sessions (Monday through Friday) offered from June 29 – August 21. Hours will be 9:00 A.M. - 4:30 pm. Early drop off 8 – 9 am or 8:30 – 9:00 am & Extended Care is available until 5:30 pm. for an additional fee.

## CAMP FEES

### EARLY DROP OFF & EXTENDED CARE

The PREPAID fees are listed below. Please note your needs on your child's registration form

8:00 – 9:00 am \$100.00 per week

8:30 – 9:00 am \$ 50.00 per week

4:30-5:30 p.m. \$100.00 per week

\*\*Early drop off & Extended care for *campers not previously signed up* will be provided at a rate of \$6.00 per 15 minutes, **payable at drop-off & pick-up time of that day.**

*IF space allows*, we will accommodate individual day registrations (minimum of 2 days per session) starting the Thursday before each session.

### CAMP SITE/ ACTIVITIES



The day will start at Fidelity House but campers will also utilize Fidelity House's site 2 /play area with access to sprinkler/ water activities and large outdoor space. We also will offer modified field trips and special events. The camp offers a variety of recreational activities geared to the 5

& 6 year old child. Some of the activities, adapted for health & safety, include:

## REGISTRATION STEP BY STEP

# 1

### At Initial Registration

Please fill out the double sided registration form per child and leave a deposit. A **\$100.00 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit per week** (per child) is required to hold the spot and they are registered once the deposit is made. Please note your deposit will be credited toward the camp fee **and is not an additional fee.** Enrollment is accepted on a first come, first served basis.

### Before Attendance at Camp

- 1). Any **BALANCE DUE** for the upcoming week must be paid the preceding Friday.
- 2). A **DOCTOR signed/MEDICAL (Immunization) RECORD is mandatory** and requested 1 WEEK before your child attends.
- 3). **Department of Early Education and Care FORMS are mandatory** and requested 1 WEEK before your child attends camp.
- 4). **ALL MEDICATIONS** (short term/long term) **require a medication authorization on file.** Please request the form if applicable.



## SWIM LESSONS

Learning to swim has always been an important part of our camp structure. We offer Red Cross certified swim lessons taught by our Certified Pool Staff.



## \*AUGUST 24 – SEPTEMBER 1 PROGRAMS

Kindergarten & 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Camp programming will be available August 24- September 1. Due to staffing and space availability, registration will be limited to youth attending during our Summer 2026 and 2026 School Age Child Care Program. Contact Fidelity House for registration form.

### While attending Camp

**DAILY** items campers bring *regardless of the weather.* Also, all items should be clearly **marked with the child's name.** **WATER BOTTLE, LUNCH, DRINKS, SNACKS, SNEAKERS, SUNSCREEN, BATHING SUIT, TOWEL**
